OVERVIEW

In today's dynamic government contracting environment, keeping up-to-date on current issues is a real challenge. Interpreting the impact on your business is even more of a challenge.

Government contractors are currently operating in a period of budget uncertainty and potential government shutdowns and program cuts. Changes in Public Law, the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR), the Defense Acquisition Regulation Supplement (DFARS) and the Cost Accounting Standards (CAS) are, among other things, impacting how contractors establish internal business systems, determine and disclose executive compensation, monitor ethical compliance, contract for new business and account for contract costs.
